I. Artist Statement

The Monument Arts design for the **Larry H. Miller Tribute Monument** invites visitors to interact with the elements of his life as depicted here. The bas relief panels on the curved wall portray moments and elements of his life.

1. Entrepreneur
2. Teacher
3. Family man
4. Philanthropist
5. Patriot
6. Builder
7. Athlete – fast-pitch Softball pitcher
8. Utah advocate
9. Race car enthusiast and collector
10. Owner – Utah Jazz, Salt Lake Bees

Our design reflects an approach to monuments that invites the viewer to participate in the message of the person being honored. By design, the Larry H. Miller Tribute Monument takes a contemporary approach that produces an interactive, inspirational, and educational experience for the viewer. While recognizing Mr. Miller as the great leader that he was, the design creates an environment at a scale that is personal to the viewer. We have chosen to balance the art with an interactive experience.

Design details include:

- Upon approaching the monument, the viewer immediately understands that this is an interactive experience. Viewers are drawn into the various elements of the monument.
- The bronze of Mr. Miller is life-size (adjusted for outdoor application) and is elevated slightly, perhaps on an elevated portion of the ground. Detail is fully depicted and realistic. He is standing in a familiar pose and is leaning on a “rubbing post”. This pedestal is four sided, with text and quotes of Mr. Miller. Each text grouping is formatted in an 8½ x 11 size to facilitate children and students making a “rubbing” of the words they choose.
- The bronze bas relief panels will be attached to the curved wall. The panels will be at a comfortable eye level. The title of the monument will be his familiar quote, *“Go about doing good, until there is too much good in the world.”*

II. Tribute Statement

The proposed tribute statement will be located on the rubbing post and perhaps on the bottom of the curved wall.
